

Envoyer

The mass notification system is a tool that will allow the emergency team to send alert messages via the following applications:

SMS If you have a registered cell phone number
 Email If you have a registered email address
 Phone Call If you have a registered phone number

• Message on computer screen If the Alertus application is installed on your computer

(Next development phase)

The registration of phone numbers and an email address is highly recommended but not mandatory. This information will not be transferred to the HR system; it is used for the sole purpose of notification in emergencies in the Valise de garde software.

M. / Mme (Mr. or Mrs.)

This field must contain M. or Mme

Nom et Prénom (Name and first name)

These fields cannot be edited. If there is an error, you must:

- 1. Contact the human resources department to correct the error
- 2. Write a note in the box "Commentaires à l'intention du responsable du bottin" at the bottom of the form.

Sous-groupe(s) IAF (Subgroup IAF)

These checkboxes are used to send alerts to the right buildings. For example, if there is an alarm in building 18, it is probably not necessary to send the alert to another building.

You must check the building in which you usually work <u>and</u> the box « IAF - Étudiants ». Do you also work in building 26? It would be a good idea to also check « Édifice 26 » in order to be notified if something happens in building 26.

Alerts are sent by building number, if no building is checked, you will not receive alerts.

The phone numbers

- You can enter the phone numbers that will allow the mass notification system to reach you.
- You can have up to 5 phone numbers :
 - o Téléphone résidence (Home phone)
 - o Téléphone résidence secondaire (Secondary home phone)
 - Téléphone bureau (Office phone)
 - o Téléphone cellulaire (Cell phone)
 - o Téléavertisseur alphanumérique (Alphanumeric Pager)

Although this is not recommended, you may decide to not register a phone number or an email but in this case, the system will not be able to contact you in a case of an emergency.

PRIORITÉ D'APPEL (Call priority). This field is used to determine the order in which you want
the mass notification system to call your different numbers. For example, if we have a priority
« 2 » on Tél. résidence and « 1 » on Cell., the first call will be to Cell and if there is no response,
the system will call Tél. résidence.

If a phone number has no priority, no call will be sent to that number; you must enter a priority number for each phone number in the list.

- For the SMS, a cell phone number is required.
- For the Office number, if it is not a direct line, you must provide an extension number.
- BE CAUTIOUS: If 5 persons share the same extension and each person registers this extension number in the file, 5 calls will be made to this extension...

Courriel (Email)

Envoyer

An email is also sent by the mass notification system. If you wish to receive email alert messages, you must enter a valid email address.

Note - Commentaire à l'intention du responsable du bottin

(Note – Comment to the person responsible for the directory)

If you wish to leave a comment, ask a question, etc., to the person responsible for the directory, you can write it in this box.

(Send)

The system is programmed to send a reminder if the file is not updated. To avoid receiving unnecessary reminders, you must click the button ENVOYER even if no information has been changed or added.
